## **Chester County Economic Development Council Names three new members of Board of Directors**

Velte is Senior Director of Human Resources for Analytical Graphics Inc. of Exton. She is a graduate of Caldwell College and has worked in the pharmaceutical and manufacturing industries.

She serves on a number of other boards and committees, including the Innovative Technology Action Group (ITAG) and Girls Exploring Tomorrow's Technology (GETT). Velte is also an advisory board member for Penn State Great Valley and Villanova University.

He previously served as vice president of public affairs at the Pharmaceutical Research and Manufacturers Association, where he worked on many critical industry issues, including the passage of a meaningful prescription drug benefit for Medicare beneficiaries.

He also worked at the Blue Cross and Blue Shield Association developing public awareness. Molineaux also worked as a public affairs executive for both the federal Departments of Health and Human Services and Agriculture, and on the White House staff of President George H. W. Bush.

Molineaux is co-chair of We Work for Health Pennsylvania and serves on the Hershey Center for Applied Research Scientific Advisory Committee, the University City Science Center Community Development Committee, and the WHYH Health & Science Advisory Committee.
